## **Cooledge fires career high series:**



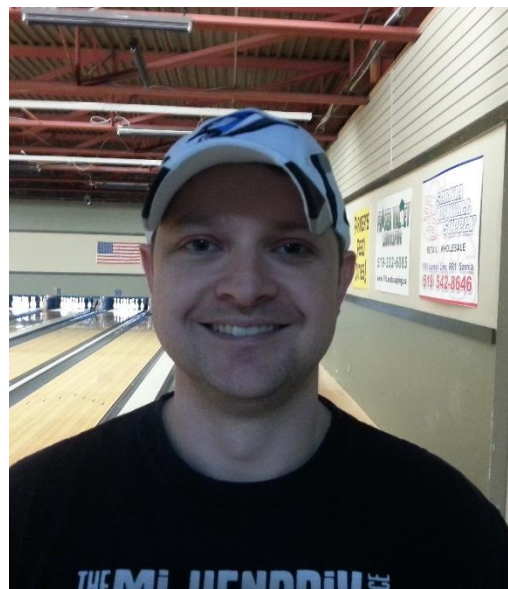
Craig Cooledge fired 721 (248-243-230 – 142 pins over average for three games) on lanes 27 & 28 in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to register his career highest series in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling this past week. Cooledge started bowling at age 13 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program but hasn't been in league bowling for several years. When he started bowling in the TNML in the 2017-2018 season he finished the year with a 169 average. Last year he finished with a 179 average. This

year the once a week bowler is averaging 195 after 54 games. The right handed bowler has a career high single game of 268. He is a member of team "Alvin Painting" which joined the TNML three years ago. Other members of the team are Mike Maheu, Mac Haddon, Jordan Colhuan, Pat Rondinei and Jahn Budziewicz.



### **Patterson rolls top single:**

Ty Patterson tossed the first eleven strikes in game one only to come high on the head pin on his last shot leaving the 4-6-7-10 split finishing with a 296 to post the high single in LCTA bowling action this past week. He was bowling in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) at Hi-Way Bowl on lanes 11 & 12 ending the night with a solid 727 (296 – 94 pins over average – 214 – 217). He established new personal high scores beating his previous high single of 290 and rolling his personal high triple. Patterson started bowling at age 12 in the Youth Bowling Program at the defunct Lake Huron Lanes, where Sunripe is presently located. His family were co-owners of the bowling alley with Brian Wickens at the time so he had lots of opportunities to practice to sharpen up his game. Ty is a once a week bowler having participated in the TTML with consistency for over a decade. His averages for the last the last nine years starting in the 2010-2011 season and working upward were 195–193--192–195–193–195–197–201–198 and 202. This year he is averaging 202 after 66 games.



### **Shura is youth high over average:**



Joshua Shura fired 279 (109 pins over average) in his second game of the day in the Junior Division in the Youth Bowling Program at Marcin Bowl to post the youth high over average for a single game in this week's LCTA bowling action. He also established a new personal high single game beating his previous 269. He finished the day with a 610 triple. Joshua's personal high triple is 685. He is currently averaging 172 after 57 games in the league. Last year he finished with a 158 average for 84 games.



**Windover tops his best single:**

Joe Windover rolled 235 (88 pins over average) in his last game of the day in the Intermediate Division in the Youth Bowling Program at Marcin Bowl to register his highest personal single and the youth second high over average for a single game this week. His previous high single was 225 and his highest triple is 568. He is currently averaging 147 after 57 games this year. Last year Joe finished with a 153 average for 87 games. Joe started bowling at age 6 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the 2010-2011 bowling season finishing the year with a 51 average for 87 games. He has been successful over the years in tournament action. In London in 2015, when he was 12

years old, he tasted victory in the Ontario Youth Tenpin Singles Tournament winning the Boys 12 and Over Handicap Division. He defeated 58 combatants to earn \$250.00 in scholarship money. Windover is doing the Youth Bowling Tour this season and last month in Burlington he won his division earning \$125.00 in scholarship money. Off the lanes, besides going to school he works part time at New York Fries. He also enjoys playing baseball and helps with umpiring to keep himself busy in the summer.

**Callander solid on the lanes:**

Rigby Callander tossed 576 (212- 65 pins over average -183-181 – 135 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl. Mr. Callander was born in Sarnia in 1932 which makes him 88 years young and he has been bowling in the TNML at Marcin Bowl for 62 years (previously a Dow Chemical League). Rigby's highest sanctioned scores are 663, single game 277 and a 176 average that he finished with in the 2001-2002 bowling season. The once a week right handed bowler is currently averaging 149 after 60 games. He said his average is going down these days but he is still having fun on the lanes with his fellow bowlers. He was introduced to 5 pin bowling as a teen, bowling at Mitton Street



Bowl and the downtown National Club Lanes where he earned spending money as a pin setter. He eventually switched to 10-pin in his early twenties and the rest is history. When this writer highlighted Rigby last year he said "I love to bowl 10-pin and GOD willing, with good health, I will continue to bowl until they carry me off the lanes. HAPPY BOWLING EVERYONE"
