



Fraser tosses perfect game:




Caulin Fraser tossed twelve consecutive strikes in his second game of the day to record a perfect game and take the honours for the high single of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling activity this week. He was bowling in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl on lanes 25 & 26 finishing the day with a notable 730 (300 -103 pins over average – 139 pins over average for three games). It was his career 2nd 300 (first one bowled in January 28, 2018 in the SMML) and the 6th perfect game in the LCTA 2019-2020 bowling season. Fraser is averaging 197 after 63 games in the SMML this year. Caulin started bowling at age 5 coming up

through the SOCMO (Sombra, Courtright and Mooretown) Youth bowling organization. His most memorable moment besides his first 300 was a few years ago he had the first 5 strikes then put his back out but still managed to bowl a 289.



Armstrong takes first place:

John Armstrong fired 753 (236-249-268 - 144 pins over average for three games) on lanes 27 & 28 to record the high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. He posted the solid series in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl. John started bowling 10-pin at age 20 and has been enjoying the fun on the lanes for 20 years. He says bowling is his passion. He has 2-300's, his first one was in 2009 in Ruthven near Kingsville. He rolled his second perfect game in December, 2018 at Chatham Bowlerama (CB). His career highest sanctioned triple is 792 which he posted in 2009. He is averaging 203 after 69 games this year.



Creasor one pin behind:



Jim Creasor rolled 752 (258-248-246) on lanes 33 & 34 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple in LCTA action this past week. Creasor is having a super year in the BMNML having tossed the following additional triples: 707 - 752 - 774 - 707 - 784 - 702 - 752 - 756 - 778 - 784 - 807. He is holding down the top average in the BMNML with 229.75 followed by Stephane Sirois at 224 and Jim Lapointe 223.


Sirois rolls third high triple:

Sirois is averaging 207 after 60 games in the league. The right handed kegler has 2-300's to his credit and his career highest triple is 791.

Karyne Legault wheeled 683 (257-236) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League at Marcin Bowl to lead the way for the ladies this week in LCTA bowling action. The right handed bowler is having a solid year this year averaging 210 after 54 games in the league. Karyne started 10 pin bowling at the age of four coming up through Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl youth bowling programs and the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) at Northgate Bowl. Her bowling program accomplishments include victories in the 2002 YBC Nationals in New Brunswick, 2005 CYC (Christian Youth Camps) Nationals in British Columbia, 2009 CYC

Nationals In Winnipeg and 2010 Team Canada in Finland. She has 1-300 to her credit and her high triple is 797.

Lucas tosses personal best triple:


Jason Lucas tossed 658 (227-231 – 70 pins over average – 175 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) to record his career personal highest triple and the high over average for three games. Lucas joined the BCML in the 2015-2016 season and finished with a 155



average. He has increased his average in subsequent years to 162 – 166 – 171. This year his average has dropped slightly to 163 after 69 games for the once a week bowler. Jason's personal best single game is 255.

Shoults posts first 600 triple:

Mike Shoults rolled 604 (223 – 70 pins over average – 142 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to post his career first 600 triple and the week's second high over average for three games. Shoults started bowling at age 46 when friends asked him to



bowl in a league at the defunct Lakeside Bowl where he got hooked on bowling and has been enjoying the fun on the lanes for 19 years. He later joined a mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl and eventually ended up at Marcin Bowl where he bowls in two leagues: the TNML and the Triple A Mixed League (TAML). Mike has carried a consistent average over the years in both leagues. In the TAML, his averages from the 2010-2011 and moving upward to the 2018-2019 season were 155 - 155 - 154 - 159 - 155 - 158 - 152 - 154 - 155. This year he is slightly lower averaging 146 after 66 games. In the TNML, his averages from the 2010-2011 and moving upward to the 2018-2019 season were 157 - 156 - 160 - 155 - 153 - 154 - 156 - 157 - 155. This year he is averaging 156 after 69 games. His highest single game is 250 which he rolled at Hi-Way Bowl. Mike also plays recreational hockey to keep himself busy in the winter. Part of his routine to pass time in the summer months involves a fishing pole in his hands and chasing the white ball on the golf course.

Ingles fires personal high scores:



Last week this writer missed some great scores on a youth bowler so this bowler is being highlighted this week. Blake Ingles wheeled 527 (229 – 89 pins over average) in the Youth Phantom Intermediate Division at Hi-Way bowl to register his personal highest scores. His high single game was also his first ever clean game meaning he had all strikes or spares with no open frames. This past week he also had a 204 (61 pins over his average) game. Blake started bowling in 2013 at age 9 in the Youth Phantom League at Hi-Way Bowl and is in his 7th year of having fun on the lanes. He has always used a one arm swing delivery but has enjoyed watching two-handed bowlers. Last year he asked if he could switch to a two-handed delivery. His coaches and parents said no to his suggestion indicating the one-handed

approach was better. At the end of last season, the league was having a fun day and



Blake asked once again if he could try the two-handed shot. Everyone said "go for it". Everyone was amazed on the control he had with the two-handed approach as opposed to his one-handed style. This year Blake is using the two handed delivery resulting in raising his average by 11 pins. His final average last year was 132 and this year he is averaging 143 after twenty weeks on the lanes.

How did Blake get interested in bowling? The answer is simple. His mother "Sarah" came up through the 5pin league at Marcin Bowl with her dad as a coach. Later, she put bowling on the back burner for a while but once again wanted to get back into bowling. Some of her family members were already bowling 10-pin at Hi-Way Bowl so she decided to join the league with Blake joining the youth league and the rest is history.

During the summer months Blake keeps himself busy "scootering" at the skate parks. He also delivers the "Sarnia Journal" to his 120 residents faithfully every single week which he has done for the last 6 years.

Fiddy tops his previous high triple:



Mack Fiddy rolled 526 (185) in the Youth Senior Division at Marcin Bowl to top his previous high triple of 505. His personal high single game is 214. This is the first year that Mack is participating in an organized league and he is currently averaging 149 after 63 games.

<u>Pelkie named to All-SWIBC list, makes all-tournament team at circuit championships</u>

SHAWNEE, Okla. (Feb. 9, 2020) – Oklahoma Christian's <u>Morgan Pelkie</u> made the All-Southwest Intercollegiate Bowling Circuit honor list that was announced Sunday at the end of the SWIBC Championships at Firelake Bowl.

Pelkie, a freshman from Sarnia, Ontario, was the Eagles' only All-SWIBC representative. She also was the only OC player to roll all nine team games in the tournament, finishing fifth with





a total score of 1,788 to make the all-tournament team.

It was Pelkie's third all-tournament award this season in SWIBC play, as she also posted top-five finishes in the SWIBC V and SWIBC VI events. She had a season scoring average of 181.31 over 48 games entering the SWIBC Championships.

OC finished fifth of six teams in the circuit tournament with

a score of 7,997 over nine games. The Eagles missed qualifying for bracket play by 61 pins.

The Eagles will compete in the Tier I Columbia 300 Hoosier Classic on Saturday and Sunday in Indianapolis to finish the regular season.
