Hall of Fame Policy (04-2014-036)

Hall of Fame recipients will be selected from <u>current LCTA</u> <u>dues paying members</u> that have achieved personal, local, provincial, national or international recognition in the sport of ten pin bowling. The Hall of Fame award would recognize, but not be limited to the raising of the bar locally, provincially or nationally. It would include breaking the current top series award, the setting of a new record in the LCTA jurisdiction that is not replicated by multiple bowlers, recognition of local, provincial or national high average. Naming to the national or provincial team. Individual achievement in placing in the top three of a recognized sanctioned tournament (i.e. World's). These recipient's names would appear on the LCTA Hall of Fame plaque and would be given a token memento, recognizing their achievement. All nominations to be received by the Association Manager no later than June 15th of the current bowling season. A Hall of Fame Committee will be struck in February immediately prior to the AGM.

The Hall of Fame Committee will be defined under LCTA job descriptions.
