## **Cole fires top triple:**

Bill Cole fired 743 (267- 63 pins over average – 266 – 131 pins over average for three games) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. Bill started bowling 10-pin at age 12 coming up through the SoCoMo (Sombra, Courtright, Mooretown) Youth League at the defunct Airey Lanes under the watchful eyes of coach Bud Sparling. He has been knocking the pins down for 48 years. Bill is a diehard bowler and loves going to out of town tournaments. Some



of his bowling trips are out of the norm however like driving to Corpus Christi and Reno by himself on 6 day return trips to bowl 9 games. His bowling trip with team "Marcin Bowl Two", a couple years ago could also be questionable as the five Lambton County



bowlers drove 10,000 kilometers (El Paso, Grand Canyon, California, Las Vegas) in 10 days. That was a memorable trip!! Bill is also a diehard Miami Dolphin fan which is hard to be this year. He has been known to drive to Miami for a weekend game. Bill also goes to Ontario tournaments with a dedicated group of 7 other bowlers. These tournaments include the Ontario Tenpin Provincial Tournament, the Jack Erb Memorial Ontario Seniors Tournament and the Seniors Double Tournament. He is bowling in two leagues this year – the TNML where he is averaging 206 after 36 games and the Border City Men's League where he is averaging 194 after 36 games. His career sanctioned high scores are 766 and 4-300's.

**Sirois rolls high single:**



Stephane Sirois rolled the last eleven strikes in a row on lanes 17 & 18 in his first game of the night to finish with a 290 to record the high single of the week in LCTA bowling action. He was participating in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 736 (254) triple which was good for the week's second high triple. Stephane bowled full time in three leagues last year but this year he is bowling full time in only one league which is the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl. He is also sparing in other leagues as required. Last year in the BCML he finished with a 208 average.

This year he is averaging 202 after 27 games. He has 2-300's, 1-299 and 1-298 to his credit.

Marc Renaud tossed 723 (248-267) in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at



Marcin Bowl to record the week's third high triple in LCTA action. Marc started bowling at age 8 in the youth bowling program called "Sports Club 444" at Bowlero Bowl in Windsor and he has been hitting the lanes for twenty plus years. He has a career 6-300's and 2-800's (800-801). His

bowling achievements include converting the 7-10 split 2 times. The once a week right handed bowler throws a ton of revs and is

currently leading the league in the high average department with 227 after 30 games. His closest competitor is Larry Plumb with 217 after 36 games. Last year he finished with a 224 average in the TNML.
