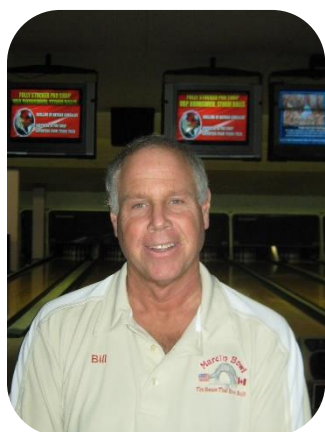

Marciniszyn started in the Youth Bowling Program at Marcin Bowl when he was 4, and bowled for 4 years until he quit to join youth hockey. He started working at Marcin Bowl in 1997 and would bowl for fun after work. He joined a league the next year and would bowl up to 20 practice games after almost every shift at the alley. Mike bowled so many games that he improved very rapidly, averaging over 200 after just 2 seasons, thanks to some coaching from his sisters Pam and Deanna, as well as other fellow bowlers. Marciniszyn has bowled in several



leagues at Marcin Bowl over the years including 1046 Mixed League, Imperial Oil Men's League, Border City Men's League, Bluewater Monday Night Men's League, Sunday Morning Men's League, as well as the Cowboys and Indians League and the Monday Night Mixed at Port Huron Lanes. Starting from the 2010-2011 season and moving upward he has averaged 220 for the last 10 seasons in the SMML (218 – 217 – 217 – 217 – 216 – 218 – 223 – 224 – 229 and 223). This year Marciniszyn is having a super year in the SMML averaging 231 after 36 games.

Cole is perfect:



Bill Cole fired the first ten strikes on his last game of the night with good pocket hits mixed with a couple mixers. Cole set himself on the approach for his eleventh delivery feeling the adrenalin flowing with the RPM's in his heart picking up to go along with the sweaty hands. He proceeded with a good rolling ball that came a bit high on the headpin. He momentarily left the 4-9 split but got a huge break when the 4 pin toppled over hitting the 9 pin and knocking it over. On his final shot he fired a solid pocket hit for a perfect game earning him the honours for the high single in LCTA bowling action this week. He was sparing in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl. It was his career 5th 300 and also the 5th recorded in the LCTA this season. He finished the night with a 715 (190-225-300) triple. Cole has been really hot on the lanes the last three weeks. This past week he tossed 711 (290-83 pins over average) in the Sunday Morning Men's League at Marcin Bowl for his third consecutive 700 in the league. His other two were 719 (220-268-231) and 716 (278-235).

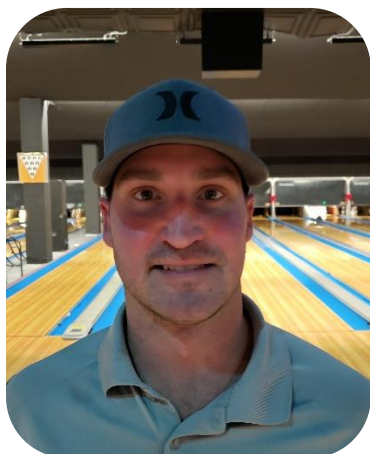
Ridealgh takes second place:

Bill Ridealgh fired 775 (277-241-257 – 121 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to slide into second place in the LCTA high triple race this week. Ridealgh started bowling at age 6 coming up through the Phantom Youth Bowling Program at Hi-Way Bowl and has been enjoying the friendship with fellow bowlers on the lanes for the last thirty-five years. He has career sanctioned high scores of



789 and 2-300's in his pocket. He is bowling in two leagues this year with present averages and games in brackets: the TNML 225 (18) and the Sunday Morning Men's League 200 (36).

Best good for third spot:



Brad Best rolled 742 (217-258-267 – 145 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to post the LCTA's third high triple of the week. Best started bowling at age 5 coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and has been knocking down the pins for 18 years. His career sanctioned high scores are 287 and 746. He is bowling in three leagues this year at Marcin Bowl with present averages and games in brackets: the SMML 204 (30), the Border City Men's League 201 (15) and Thursday Night Men's League 211 (21).

Romlewski is high over average:

John Romlewski had a super night as he wheeled 691 (236-234-221 – 178 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's (BMNML) League at Marcin Bowl to record the week's high over average for three games. Romlewski's averages for the last ten years in the BMNML starting from the 2010-2011 season and moving upward were 165 – 170 – 169 – 174 – 163 – 161 – 167 – 169 – 164 and 167. This year he is averaging 178 for 24 games.
